

Biography of Mr. Md Abdul Jalil

Mr. Md. Abdul Jalil was born on 21 October 1959 in Sylhet district of Bangladesh. He has completed his Post graduation in Economics from the University of Chittagong. Then he joined in Bangladesh Civil Service on 21 January 1986. At present he is working as the Secretary of the Ministry of Religious Affairs. He has been working as a Civil Servant of the People's Republic of Bangladesh for the past 30 years. As the Principal Accounts Officer and the Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry, he plays an active role in policy & decision making process. Besides his routine duties as the Secretary of the Ministry, he also plays important role regarding social harmony, ideals and values and anti-terrorism. His primary focus is to maintain the harmony among people of different religions and also to motivate and aware people against religious extremism. Prior to this, he worked as the Director General of Department of Land Records and Surveys where he was in the charge of implementation of the historical land boundary agreement 1974 and the Protocol 2011 with India. He also served as the Divisional Commissioner of Khulna Division, the highest post of Bangladesh Field Administration.
